



Important Water System Rules

Members of Far Hills Association equally share the cost of drinking water as well as the cost to maintain our water distribution system. Therefore, we have developed rules to help control our costs and avoid unnecessary water uses and losses. These rules are included in the FHA Handbook [[link to "Rules"](#)] and are briefly summarized below:

1. The water shutoff valve (the "curbstop") near the street for each home should be operated only by an FHA-designated person. If an unauthorized person operates the valve and causes damage or undue water loss, the member may be fined.
2. Drinking water can be used for normal household purposes only. No commercial use is permitted.
3. Water leaks in home service lines and plumbing are to be repaired as soon as possible. Excessive water leaks due to inadequate detection and/or response are subject to fines by the Association
